CPR For Family and Friends - Thursday, February 11, 1-3 pm, C-200. Education for those interested in learning basic life skills but having no need for certification. This instructor led class includes infant, adult and child CPR with full-sized mannequins being used. An AED demonstration will be included. Cost is \$25.

Heartsaver/AED - Saturday, February 20, 9am- noon in C-200. Education for those who need certification documenting completed training in CPR/AED and First Aid for job or other requirements. This class includes adult and child CPR but no infant instruction. Cost is \$35.

CPR in a Box - Wednesday, February 24, 1 pm, C-200. An instructor led course in CPR that includes a kit that participants will take home. Two or three family members may come to the class which where they will use the personal mannequin that is included with each kit. Adult, child and infant CPR will be taught as well as AED demonstration. Cost is \$30 per CPR in a Box Kit; registration includes up to three people attending the 2 hour class.
